Negotiations Update for 2023-2024 11/2/2023

The GGEA bargaining team met with the District 11/2/23 at the GGEA office. GGEA and GGUSD discussed

- Presenter pay
- 2025-2026 Calendar
- Preschool Assessment Center working conditions
- Changes to the SPED Side Letter

Agreements reached:

- Extra duty pay for teachers in Musical Director positions.
- Article 12.3i TK 6 Assignments
- Remove:
 - Department Chair-Elementary Music Teacher Annual Rate of 4% of Group 1, Step 1 *
- Article 12.3j
 VAPA Assignments*
- *These assignments are separate from the Visual and Performance assignments in sections 12.3a 7-8 Assignments and 12.3b 9-12 Assignments
 - Department Chair Elementary Instrumental Music Annual Rate of 4% of Group 1, Step 1*
 - Department Chair General Music
 Annual Rate of 4% of Group 1, Step 1*
 - Department Chair Elementary Art
 Annual Rate of 4% of Group 1, Step 1*
 - Department Chair Elementary Dance
 Annual Rate of 4% of Group 1, Step 1*
- GGUSD recognizes the need for extra duty pay for musicals. Extra-duty pay is what would be offered.
- Adding TK-6 Grade Level Chair Election procedures to the contract
- Changes to the PAR side letter.
 - There will be one (1) formal interview of the candidate with all Joint Panel members and one (1) unannounced classroom observation by teacher and administrator who are Joint Panel members.

The next bargaining session is November 30, 2023.

Recently GGEA received a request from members regarding how to opt out of the messages from the District.

Below is the information and link provided by the District: In their account profile, under Notification settings, they can turn off receiving posts via email, text and/or app. They can choose to turn them off from the district but leave them on from their school site if they choose. They can also turn off alerts. They cannot turn off receiving urgent alerts from the district. They would need to unsubscribe to do this which would disable their account.
