## **GGEA/GGUSD Contract Calendar Guidelines**

The following information is the contractual guidelines for establishing each school year calendar. Based on previous input from GGEA Contract Surveys, this is unlikely to change for the 2010-2011 school year. Keep these dates in mind when giving your input through the 2010-2011 Contract Survey. These are tentative guidelines because we have not reach agreement with the District on the calendar. This will be done in the next session of negotiations, which will not begin until May.

- Opening Date For Teachers: Day after Labor Day (September 7, 2010)
- Veterans' Day: November 11 (Thursday, November 11, 2010)
- Thanksgiving Recess: Fourth Thursday in November and the following Friday (November 26-27)
- Winter Recess: Begins Monday prior to December 25 (December 20-31)
- Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day: Third Monday in January (January 17, 2011)
- Lincoln Day: If it falls on a Saturday, the holiday will be Friday (February 11, 2011)
- Presidents Day: Third Monday in February (February 21, 2011)
- Spring Recess: To be negotiated
- Memorial Day: Last Monday in May (May 30, 2011)
- Local Holiday: To be negotiated (will be dependent on Contract Survey feedback and the placement of Spring Recess)

As communicated earlier, there still exists the possibility of Budget Cut Days for the 2010-2011 school year. The placement of these days, if implemented, will be decided through the negotiations process. The direction the GGEA Board of Directors gives the team will be dependent upon Contract Survey feedback as well. Again, these are tentative dates to use as a guideline; they are not set in stone.
