Revised Budget Repays Schools- Settles CTA Lawsuit

The May revision of the Governor's budget restores all the money owed to our schools under Prop. 98 and settles the lawsuit over education funding. CTA has been committed to restoring funds and increasing resources to our schools. If adopted, public schools will receive \$5 billion as repayment of the money owed under the 2004 agreement with the education community and the school's share of new state revenues.
