

# Think proposed cuts to education funding won't affect you? Think again!

*A statewide \$7.2 billion cut is equivalent to:  
\$1,200 per student or \$31,500 per classroom  
\$80 million projected shortfall in GGUSD  
over the next 3 years!!!*



Here's what could happen to  
Garden Grove teachers over the next 3 years:



- Higher class sizes
- Elimination of CSR & other programs
- Furlough Days
- Higher Health Benefits Costs
- Frozen Salary Schedule
- Reduced Stipend Positions
- Less Classroom Supplies
- Salary Cuts

That type of cut is equal to one of the following for  
California public schools statewide:

- Shutting down every school across the state for 25 days
- Increasing class sizes statewide by over 50 percent
- Laying off of 160,000 classroom teachers
- Laying off of 180,000 bus drivers, custodians, food service workers, maintenance workers, and school clerks
- Eliminating all elective and career technical education programs state-wide with room to cut more
