



## GGEA Recommendations for Community Organizing



The Governor and Legislature are poised to cut billions from the K-12 Education funding for this year and 2009-10. Some of the cuts are **permanent reductions** in Proposition 98 funding, which means that they will carry over for years to come. It is important that we get the word out to our students' parents and the community. Please follow the guidelines below to ensure this is done in an appropriate manner.

GGEA recommends that you **DO** the following:

- Inform parent members of your School Site Council
- Get on the agenda at your PTA or PTO meeting
- Call your ELAC committee members
- Meet with your athletic and/or music booster club members
- Talk to the parents at Ten Commandments trainings
- Relay the information to other interested parents

GGEA cautions you about the following:

- Don't talk to parents or students during instructional time
- Don't talk to parents or students during your work hours (one half hour before and fifteen minutes after school)
- Don't use school copiers for any organizing efforts.
