

APPLICATION FOR ELEMENTARY PAR PANEL MEMBER

GGUSD and GGEA signed a side letter regarding the Peer Assistance and Review (PAR) Program in May of 2000. The Agreement states that any permanent teacher receiving an unsatisfactory evaluation in instructional skills, classroom management or knowledge of subject matter will be referred to PAR and that the PAR Panel shall interview and select Consulting Teachers to coach them.

Members of the PAR Panel are responsible for overseeing the Peer Assistance and Review Program, evaluating the needs of the referred teachers, and interviewing and selecting qualified Consulting Teachers for all referred teachers. The term is two school years, although a Panel Member may serve more than one term.
