The GGEA bargaining team met with the District 4/5/24 at the GGEA office.

GGEA and GGUSD discussed the following:

- Wages: The wage proposal from GGUSD remains at 3.5%
- Special Education MOU Caseload/Class Size Cap for M/M and M/S Teachers
- MM/SPED Inclusion in the General Education classroom
- Optional Early Start for Nurses

Agreements Reached:

- Special Education MOU Caseload/Class Size Cap for M/M and M/S Teachers
- MM/SPED Inclusion in the General Education classroom






# TheSTANDARD

#### CTA-Retired Membership

GGEA will purchase a one-year membership in the Orange Service Center Retired Chapter and California Teachers Association-Retired (CTA-R) - CTA/NEA Retired for retiring teachers who are GGEA members. GGEA will apply the one-year membership dues towards a lifetime membership if requested by the retiring member. #### Helpful Tax Information

Remember to ask your tax advisor if your professional association dues are tax deductible. The amount paid monthly for GGEA/CTA/NEA dues for the 2023 tax year is as follows:

#### Category 1 GGE Members

(Full-time Employment) January thru June a t\$119.20 September thru December at \$121.40 Year Total = \$1200.80

Leave of Absence Members-per month January thru June at \$36.55 September thru December at \$37.10 Category 2 GGEA Members

(Preschool, Job Share, Part Time or JROTC) January thru June at \$64.25 September thru December at \$65.35 Year Total = \$646.90

Please refer to your pay stubs for the actual amounts you paid during the 2023 tax year as these are general estimates. Contact your tax advisor with any questions regarding these tax deductions.

#### For first time users:

You will need your ten digit District Employee Identification Number, the last four digits of your social security number and birthdate.

Then you will be asked for your personal email address and to create a password. After you give answers to 3 security questions you will be able to login.


# **MESSAGE FROM THE RETIREMENT COMMITTEE**
